STANDING ORDER DISCONTINUING THE IMPOSITION OF CIVIL ASSESSMENTS UPON FAILURE TO APPEAR OR FAILURE TO PAY CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT, COUNTY OF TRINITY BY: STACI HOLLIDAY

Pursuant to Assembly Bill 199, effective July 1, 2022, the maximum civil assessment amount that can be imposed was reduced from \$300 to \$100. And all outstanding civil assessments debt as of June 30, 2022, was abolished. Effective July 1, 2022, the Superior Court of California, County of Trinity began imposing civil assessments at the reduced amount of \$100. As authorized pursuant to Penal Code section 1214.1.

BY THIS ORDER, effective May 1, 2024, the Superior Court of California, County of Trinity shall discontinue imposing civil assessments in each eligible case in which a defendant has failed to appear or failed to pay.

BY THIS ORDER, effective May 1, 2024, all outstanding debt from civil assessments imposed between July 1, 2022 and April 30, 2024 is abolished.

Subject to ongoing statutory authority, judicial discretion to impose a civil assessment remains.
